We want as many people as possible to complete the short survey, across a wide range of social care roles.

The survey will be online for six weeks. If you're a registered social care worker, we'll be in touch with more information about how to take part when it goes live in January. You'll also be able to access the survey from this page.

<u>Buckinghamshire New University</u>, <u>Bath Spa University</u> and the <u>British</u> <u>Association of Social Workers (BASW)</u> are working with us to carry out this research. All of your answers will be anonymous and we'll share the findings on our website after the results have been analysed.

What were the results of the 2024 survey?

We recently announced the results of our 2024 survey, which found that social care workers feel more valued for the work they do than they did last year, but their well-being is worse than the UK average.
