




Dementia UK 2014

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



Leading Cause of Death 2012









Dementia was the leading cause for death of women over the age of 80

 2nd leading cause of death in men over 80 after heart disease.





2/3 people with dementia live at home

1/3 live alone

83% of people with dementia would like to live at home







18,885

People over the age of 65 receiving home care services in Wales as of March 31 2011
